

- I-3-6-5 Hiram Marcus Esarey, born Mar. 9, 1847; died Feb. 13, 1929, married Barbara Louise Schnoepel, dau. of John F. Otto Schnoepel (so spelled on the marriage record) and Mahala Faulkenborough. Louise was born Aug. 18, 1851; married about 1870. Mahala Faulkenborough was the daughter of James Faulkenborough and Barbara Flie who came from North Carolina to Perry County about 1816 and opened up the farm about three miles east of Branchville, which later was the home of John W. and Mary Ellen Ewing (I-3-6-1). They lived at Bristow, Ind. until Louise died, about 1880-1882. Hiram Marcus married (2) Anna Amanda Saalman Bengal born Aug. 29, 1850; died Mar. 14, 1923; dau. of Christian and Dorothea Saalman. Dorothea later married Hiram Marcus Esarey (I-3-4). Her father, a Union soldier, died in Andersonville prison. She was the widow of William Bengal and had one son, Theodore Bengal, now of Keensburg, Ill. They lived at Branchville a short time (Dorothea and the younger Hiram) and then moved to a farm on Little Blue near Sulphur, Ind. About 1895 they moved to a farm near Keensburg, Ill. where both died. Both are buried in the Walker Cemetery, Branchville, Ind. 12 ch: Jesse Otto, Sabina Isabel, Katie Louella, Elijah, Elisha, Calvin Marcus, Eugene, Elvin, Archie and three who died in infancy.

From Ann Frakes' Scrapbook: Hiram Marcus Esarey, son of Jesse Clark Esarey and Susie Hughes Esarey was born at Branchville, Ind. on March 9, 1847 and departed this life Feb. 13, 1929, aged 81 years 11 months and 4 days. In early life he was united in marriage to Louise Sneeple and to this union three children remain: Mrs. Belle Goolzer of Petersburg, Texas; Mrs. Kate Landford of Mt. Carmel, Ill., and Elisha Esarey of Sulphur, Ind. He was later united in marriage with Mrs. Anna Saalman Bengal. Of this union four sons remain to mourn their loss: Calvin M. Esarey of Browns, Ill, Edwin Esarey of Decker, Ind. and Eugene and Archie Esarey of Keensburg, Ill. One stepson, Theodore Bengel of Keensburg, Ill. He leaves 19 grandchildren, two brothers, Felix E. Esarey of Branchville and James Esarey of Grantsburg, Ind. Three sisters, Mrs. Mary Ellen Ewing of Vincennes, Ind., Mrs. Sallie Miller of New Albany, Ind. and Mrs. Susanna Frakes of Branchville, Ind. and a host of other relatives and friends. Mrs. Esarey having departed this life March 14, 1923. In his youth he was united with the Methodist church at Branchville and helped in the erection of the present building. In his later years he helped in the building of the little church at Rochester near his home. He was a kind husband, a loving father and estimable friend and neighbor. Funeral services were held at his home near Keensburg, Ill. Mar. 14, at 2 o'clock P. M. by Rev. Story. Leaving there Friday morning with the body they arrived at Branchville where funeral services were held at the M. E. Church at 1 o'clock P. M. by Rev. Statler at the grave and F. and A. M. Lodge No. 496 had charge of the body. Interment in the Walker Cemetery.

M. at the age of 68 years 6 mos. and 15 days. She leaves to mourn her loss her husband, H. M. Esarey, four sons, Calvin, Eugene and Archie, all of Keensburg, Ill. and Elvin of Decker, Ind. and one son by a former marriage, Theodore Bangel of Keensburg, Ill. together with three stepchildren, Belle Goelzer of Petersburg, Texas, Kate Lankford of Mt. Carmel and Elisha Esarey of Sulphur, Ind. and ten grandchildren and one great-grandchild. There are also two brothers, Columbus Saalman of Branchville, Ind. and Joseph Saalman of Chicago, Ill. and a host of other relatives and friends. She was preceded in death by two infant sons and one sister, Mrs. Hermine Vaupel. She was a life long member of the Methodist church having become affiliated with the Oil Creek church in childhood, remaining firmly in that belief throughout her life. Brief services were held at her home near Keensburg, Ill. Thursday morning at 8:45 o'clock. I had forgotten it but never will I forget the wonderful books we had there. It was unusual I believe, for a school to have such a good library. It wasn't the number of volumes but the quality that was outstanding. Such selections spoke volumes for the teachers who selected them for those shelves. Another source of association with books was through good old Uncle Sol. Any birthday, holiday, or visit was certain to bring a bundle of books from him. I wish he could know how happy he made us. Then the most precious pictures of our home are the evenings after supper, all of us circling the oil lights on the table, each of us with a book or better still listening to one or the other of us reading aloud. ...The family is near enough that we can get together a couple of times a year. Clark, Norma and Mark, Duane and Lynne are at Minier near Peoria. This is his 5th year of Vo-Ag teaching. Last summer they took a trip back to Riverside, California to visit her folks. Kermit's could hardly ask for a better situation as he is only eight miles out from Urbana, at St. Joseph and is Vo-ag teacher there. It is good land, good people, good churches and good schools. Gail is finishing grade school this year. I hear she is cheer leader and enjoying the activities. Dwight Bonnie with Ricky and Pamela live 18 miles west of here. He finds being a Farm Planner in U. S. Soil Conservation Department a full time job. Wayne county is very large and he scoots all over it here and there and yonder pretty much. Now as to Jim and Emily they were in the outskirts of St. Louis at Ellisville where he was working for Doane Agriculture Agency. However he has recently been assigned to a job in the Ozarks in Arkansas at Heber Springs near Little Rock. It

This was with the family of a 90 year old aunt. While no extra large ones were caught it was wonderful fun. On top of all this, the school superintendent here has a farm pond teeming with fish. Every whipstitch I find myself perched on that bank where I zip out my line. The kids gave me a new Shakespeare spincast which is fool proof indeed. There is absolutely no backlash with it.

From Ann Frakes' Scrapbook: The Perry County spelling contest held in this city last Saturday proved decidedly interesting.
